

Regulations for Selection of Distinguished Alumni by Department of Industrial Management at I-Shou University

Adopted and promulgated on April 18, 2012 by the
Departmental Affairs Council

Article 1 The Alumni Association of Department of Industrial Management at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as the “Association”) establishes the Regulations for Selection of Distinguished Alumni by the Department of Industrial Management (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”) for awarding alumni for their outstanding contributions to the respective professional fields.

Article 2 Nominees for the award of Distinguished Alumni of the Department shall meet any one of the following qualifications:

1. those who have unique achievements, innovation or publications in their professional fields;
2. those who have dedicated themselves to serving the welfare of the people, society and the country;
3. those who have a reputation for high moral standards, whose behavior serves as an example to the public;
4. those who are outstanding entrepreneurs;
5. those who participate in activities held by the Association regularly or who enthusiastically assist with arranging such activities.

Article 3 A nominee may be proposed by:

1. at least three alumni of the Department;
2. at least three faculty members of the Department;
3. at least three staff members of the Department (including retired staff members);
4. any of the winners of the Award of Distinguished Alumni.

Any nominee shall follow the regulations of the Association to submit the relevant dossier to the Distinguished Alumni Selection Committee of the Department (hereinafter referred to as the “Committee”).

Article 4 The Committee consists of 7 members, including six members recommended by the Department, and the Chair of the Department, the ex-officio member and the convener. Members of the Committee serve for two years. The quorum of a meeting requires at least two-thirds of total members. With the consent of at least one-half of the members present, a decision may be made.

- Article 5 The selection of Distinguished Alumni shall follow the following procedures:
1. The Committee shall visit the qualified nominees who pass the primary selection.
 2. The official meeting of the Selection Committee shall follow the following principles.
 - a. All members of the Committee shall attend to the aforesaid meeting(s) in person.
 - b. The nominees' experiences, achievements and contribution shall be reviewed comprehensively before making selection.
- Article 6 Those who have won the Distinguished Alumni Award of I-Shou University shall be the Distinguished Alumni of the Department as well.
- Article 7 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation after adopted by the Departmental Affairs Council. The same procedure applies to any amendment to the Regulations.

Note : In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of these Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
