

Rules of Assessment of English Proficiency for Eligibility to Graduate from Department of Industrial Management at I-Shou University

Adopted on June 29, 2009 at the second meeting of the
University Academic Council in the second semester of the
academic year 2008

Adopted at the first meeting of the Departmental Affairs
Council in the second semester of the academic year 2011

I. Legal Basis

The Rules of Assessment of English Proficiency for Eligibility to Graduate from Department of Industrial Management at I-Shou University (hereinafter referred to as the “Rules”) are formulated by the Department of Industrial Management (hereinafter referred to as the “Department”) in accordance with the Regulations for Assessment of Basic Competence for Graduation Eligibility for Students of I-Shou University.

II. Purpose

The Rules are hereby enacted to improve students’ English proficiency to further assist them in pursuing further education and conducting personal career planning.

III. Scope of Application

The Rules are applicable to undergraduate students (include transfer students) admitted to the daytime program of the Department in the academic year 2009 and thereafter.

IV. Assessment Criteria of English Proficiency:

V. Implementation

During the prescribed duration of study, students of the Department must not only take all courses required by the Department but also fulfill the criteria on English proficiency specified above to be eligible for graduation.

VI. Measures for Failure to Fulfill the Criteria

Students who fail to pass any of the mentioned English proficiency tests are required to take the makeup course English Proficiency, which is exclusively offered to the junior and senior students, either by the Department or the General Education Center during summer or winter vacation. The standard tuition for the course shall be the same as that for any of the other summer courses. Once the students pass the evaluation test after completing the course, their score for “English Proficiency” shall be registered as “Passed”. Students who have attended the required English proficiency tests each academic year failed to meet the required standard set by the Department for at least three consecutive academic years since initial enrollment, the University shall subsidize such students half of the tuition once only when they take the makeup course.

VII. The Rules become effective after reviewed and adopted by the department-, college- and University-level of Curriculum Committees, and the University Academic Council. The same procedure applies to any amendment to the Rules.

Note : In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of these Rules, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
